- 1. The student has to prepare a proposal (write-up) with a word count of not more than 1000.
- 2. The theme or concept relating to entrepreneurship and start-up businesses should be unique and novel.
- 3. The proposal must include the sections listed below in the order listed.
  - a) *Title of the proposal*
  - b) Name of the Student
  - c) Department
  - d) Program (B. Tech/Diploma)
  - e) Semester

- f) Body of the proposal
- 4. The following sections should be included in the body of the proposal:
  - a) An overview (identification of the problem and need of your start-up business idea)
  - b) A clear objective for your start-up proposal (At least 3 objectives)
  - c) Identifying the target market, demographics, and geographic location
  - d) Competitive industries/markets in your start-up.
  - e) Proposed Budget allocation
  - f) Identification of Goals for stat-up and financial projections
  - g) Employment/Job opportunity
  - h) Marketing strategy and method for initiating your start-up business plan
  - i) Conclusion

Note: If required, figures and tables can also be added.

- 5. The proposal should not exceed 1000 words in length.
- 6. The proposal should be submitted in pdf format only and the pdf file should be named as **Udyamita 2021\_Your Name**' (e.g. if your name is Ritika Sen, the folder should be named as Udyamita 2021\_Ritika Sen).
- 7. Fill up the Google form and upload your file in pdf here.
