Chairman welcomed the members of the Finance Committee of GKCIET, Malda for participating in its 8<sup>th</sup> meeting though some members could not come over from Delhi. Chairman specially welcomed the officers of MHRD Shri D. P. Singh, Under Secretary & Shri Sat Pal Sharma, Asstt. Fin. Advisor reaching from New Delhi in spite of their busy schedule in this meeting to deliberate upon important finances of the Institute as we are jumping to the new Degree programmes shortly.

This meeting is particularly significant in view of the fast progress achieved by the Institute on all fronts, creation of building infrastructure, faculty resources and starting new Degree programmes shortly which require significant financial resources.

Dr. Rakesh Sharma, Registrar, IIT Delhi could not attend the meeting due to preoccupation.

Thereafter the agenda items were taken up as under.

Item No. F.C: 8.1: To consider and confirm the minutes of the 7<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Finance Committee, GKCIET, Malda dated-06-03-2014.

The minutes of the 7<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Finance Committee were confirmed.

# Item No. F.C: 8.2: To consider and note the Action Taken Report of the 7<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Finance Committee, GKCIET, Malda held on-06-03-2014.

It was clarified that Institute appointments were made adhering to the prescribed teacher pupil ratio taking into account the EFC approval and as per minutes of the meeting of the video conference with Joint Secretary (TEL) Department of Higher Education, Ministry of H.R.D., Govt. of India

The Action Taken Report was thus approved.

Item No. F.C: 8.3: To consider and ratify the minutes of the 8<sup>th</sup> meeting of Building & Works Committee held on 19-05-2014.

MHRD representatives were apprised of the Institute readiness to start new Degree programmes in an academic block being readied by NBCC by June 2014 as assured by its Executive Director during 8<sup>th</sup> BWC meeting on 19-05-2014. A plan-B action by creation of 6 temporary class rooms are also at hand.

The minutes of 8<sup>th</sup> BWC meeting was thus approved.

#### Item No: F.C: 8.4: To consider utilization of unspent balance of 2013-14.

Institute budget estimate 2014-15 of Rs. 188.66 crore were approved in the last BoG, taking into account the construction needs as per approved master plan. An amount of Rs. 25 crore were sought as 1<sup>st</sup> quarter grant taking into account the lab/workshop development needs for stating new Degree programmes and the time bound building construction as in progress at Narayanpur campus through NBCC.

After discussion, MHRD representatives informed to furnish details of information as required in terms of Ministry's letter no F. No. 8-4/2014-TS. VII dated 15-05-2014 to release 1<sup>st</sup> quarter grant. With the above observation unspent balance of Rs. 3,70,25,913=50 of the year 2013-14 is approved for utilization in the year 2014-15.

## Item No: F.C: 8.5: To consider the recasted Annual Accounts of GKCIET for the Financial Year 2011-12, 2012-13 as per direction of C&AG.

The recasted Annual Account for the year 2011-12 and 2012-13 were prepared as per C&AG letter no OA-II(AB)/SAR/GKCIET/2012-13/529 dated 27-03-2014 were considered and approved by the Finance Committee for submission to C&AG after vetting from Chartered Accountant as per procedure.

The Annual Accounts for year 2013-14 were also considered and approved by the Finance Committee for submission to C&AG after certification by Chartered Accountant.

Item No.F.C: 8.6: Any other item with the permission of the Chair.

Item No.F.C: 8.6 (i): Proposal for opening of a branch of Allahabad Bank with ATM facility for banking needs of the Institute and campus residents.

The Finance Committee considered the necessity of opening of abranch of Allahabad Bank with ATM facility with in the campus on suitable rent basis and approved the proposal.

Item No.F.C: 8.6 (ii): Proposal for GKCIET permanent Extension Centre at Pakua, Malda.

Institute proposal for opening a new centre to pursue its NVEQF and community college skill training programme by purchasing a newly constructed building with land measuring 4582 sq. metre and building of 697 sq. metre valued approximately at Rs. 6.5 crore was consider by Finance Committee and approved in principle.

However, a detailed report to be sent to the MHRD for consideration.
